### **BRUSH REMOVAL SERVICE OPTIONS FOR RESIDENTS ONLY**

- Residents with a current water bill and drivers license may take brush, leaves, tree limbs and grass clippings to the Convenience Station located at 1421 Avenue F at **NO CHARGE** or brush may be placed at the curb by the street and the City of Graham brush truck will pick up in 5 to 7 days. **NOTE: If tree trimming contractors are used, it is the responsibility of the contractors to remove all brush from the premises or be subject to fines set by the City.** No trash or lumber will be allowed in the brush pile. Brush put in the back alley **WILL NOT** be picked up.
- Residents are allowed **6 CY (6 cubic yards (CY) = two pickup trucks, loaded level)** of general refuse (does not include household garbage/food items) for **FREE** each year at the Convenience Station. There is also the "Keep Graham Beautiful" Spring Cleanup and Fall Cleanup for City of Graham residents only at **NO CHARGE**.

### **ANOTHER AVAILABLE OPTION IS:**

### **BULKY WASTE ITEM COLLECTION SERVICES FOR RESIDENTS ONLY**

Bulky waste should be used to dispose of items that will not fit into your residential cart. Small items such as toys, clothes, etc. must be boxed or bagged. All bulky items to be collected should be placed where you place your roll-out carts CURBSIDE in front of your house for service. Bulky items must not block collection of your roll-out carts. **NO BULKY WASTE ITEMS WILL BE COLLECTED IN ALLEYS!** It is no longer necessary to contact City Hall to schedule pickup of bulky waste items. Collection of bulky waste items is **free of charge** and will be picked up by a City of Graham truck in 5 to 7 days.

**NOTE: Illegal dumping in alleyways and city owned dumpsters may constitute a misdemeanor, for which charges may be filed in municipal court, with fines up to \$1,000 a day in addition to any fines set by the court.**

### **EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE BULKY ITEMS:**

- Old furniture such as chairs, tables, couches, recliners, lamps; white goods such as space heaters, air conditioners, clothes washers, clothes dryers, dishwashers, stoves, stereos, televisions.
- Boxes and other packaging.

The volume to be collected per customer will be limited to a total of three (3) cubic yards. Items placed on the curb should not exceed 100 lbs per item as a safety precaution for our collection personnel. **3 cubic yards = 4.5 ft wide x 4.5 ft long x 4 ft high.**

### **EXAMPLES OF UNACCEPTABLE BULKY ITEMS:**

- Anything that contains gaseous refrigerants such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioner units that contain Freon or other gaseous refrigerants unless the unit has been tagged by a licensed professional certifying the Freon has been evacuated. The tag must bear the name of the licensed professional that removed the Freon and his State license number.
- Batteries
- Regulated medical wastes
- Liquid waste
- Asbestos waste
- Radioactive waste
- Construction debris of any type
- Tires
