



City of Graham : Stage 1 Water Restrictions Effective

June 6, 2013

The City of Graham 's Stage 1 Water Restrictions become effective June 6, 2013.

Stage 1 Restrictions are voluntary and consist of a two day per week outside watering schedule.

Addresses ending in Odd numbers (1,3,5,7 and 9) are requested to water only on Wednesday and Saturday.

Addresses ending in Even numbers (0,2,4,6 and 8) are requested to water only on Thursday and Sunday.

All persons are requested to water yards and outdoor plants only between 7 p.m. and 10 a.m.

It is also requested that all users discontinue water use for non-essential or discretionary purposes such as washing down driveways and sidewalks.

Lake Graham and Lake Eddleman are now 66% full. Conservation of water during this voluntary Stage 1 restriction will help maintain lake levels and delay the need for future mandatory restrictions.

Mandatory Stage 2 restrictions may be necessary this summer if water levels drop below 55% full or if demand continues to increase.

The City of Graham thanks residents and wholesale users for their voluntary cooperation with Stage 1 restrictions.

The City of Graham Public Works Department oversees parks, cemeteries, streets, water and wastewater treatment and distribution systems. Public works employees take pride in helping Graham be a great place to live and work.
