



## Notice

In accordance with the Water Conservation & Drought Contingency Plan the City of Graham will be temporarily entering stage 5 Emergency Stage due to repairs and renovations to our water production or distribution systems. We will enter this stage effective immediately and it will be in effect until important tie-ins with the water plant renovations are done (approximately 6-8 weeks). The days and times when the stage will be in effect are starting August 18 thru October 6 from **5:00 a.m. on Tuesday until 8 p.m. on Wednesday** of each week. All outdoor, non-essential, or discretionary uses of water is prohibited during this time frame each week. It will also be imperative for each household to conserve during this time frame for these much needed repairs to be made. During the rest of the week you may water with no restrictions.
