What: Public Meeting on Sewer Plant Road Property

Where: Barclay Room at Young County Arena

When: 6 PM on Tuesday October 21, 2014

The City of Graham is exploring options for possible use of 272 acres of city owned land along the west side of Salt Creek off SH 67. The land lies along a gravel road known as Sewer Plant Road. A small piece of the land is used for the waste water treatment plant. The remainder is used as police shooting range, rented for cattle grazing, contains a communication tower or is vacant.

The City has proposed using part of the land for use by the public with all-terrain vehicles. As the city studies this option, other options have been presented. The other options include use as an equestrian park, a hiking park, a nature preserve, selling the land or doing nothing.

A public meeting will be held at the Barclay Room at the Young County Arena on Tuesday October 21, 2014 at 6 PM to discuss the options.

Available at the meeting will be a map of the area and preliminary data examining the pros and cons of each option. The public may make comments at the meeting or supply comments for 10 days after the meeting.
