



Public Notice 03/05/2020

At the recommendation of the City Manager, the Graham City Council unanimously approved an Emergency Declaration Order of Stage 4 of our City of Graham Water Conservation Plan. This order **begins at 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 5<sup>th</sup> and will continue until the leak is fixed on the evening of Monday, March 9<sup>th</sup>.** During a Stage 4 Water Conservation Stage water can only be used for essential needs. Residents are asked to refrain from outdoor watering and any other discretionary use until the Order is lifted. We do not anticipate a loss of water to any customers however you could experience lower than normal water pressure. This Order is being issued to do a badly needed repair to our main 24" waterline coming into the City of Graham. We will begin fixing the leak at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, March 9<sup>th</sup>. We anticipate the repair will take 10-16 hours. Beginning March 5<sup>th</sup> we will top off all the tanks in town and limit flows to ensure water service for essential need will not be disrupted during this repair.
