ORDINANCE # 1121

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAHAM, YOUNG COUNTY, TEXAS CANCELLING ORDINANCE #1117 ORDER OF A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 7, 2022, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING ONE (1) MAYOR AND TWO (2) COUNCIL MEMBERS (PLACES 1 AND 2); DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE; ORDERING THE POSTING OF THIS ORDINANCE AT CITY HALL AND POLLING PLACE(S) ON ELECTION DAY; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the election is for officers of the City in which each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed, and

WHEREAS, the filing deadline for name placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy have passed: and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received the City Secretary's written certification that each candidate is unopposed for the election, and

WHEREAS, in this circumstance, Section 2.053(a) of the Texas Election Code authorizes the governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and to cancel the general election thereby avoiding the expenses related to holding a general election and saving public funds

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAHAM, YOUNG COUNTY, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1; The general election for the purpose of electing one (1) Mayor and two (2) Council Members (Places 1 and 2) previously called for Saturday, May 7, 2022, is hereby canceled.

SECTION 2; The following candidates, who are unopposed for the May 7, 2022, general election is hereby declared elected to office and shall be issued a certificate-of-election at the regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the date on which the general municipal election for one (1) Mayor and two (2) Council Members (Places 1 and 2) was to have been held:

Mayor	Neal Blanton
Council Member Place 1	Shana Weatherbee-Wolfe
Council Member Place 2	Alex Heartfield

SECTION 3; The City Secretary shall post a copy of this ordinance at City Hall and on Election Day, the Young County Elections Administrator shall post a copy of this ordinance at the polling place(s).

SECTION 4; Should any word, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance or of the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, be adjudged, or held to be void or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of that remaining portions of said ordinance or the Code of Ordinances, as amended hereby, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5; This ordinance shall take effect immediately in accordance with the provision of the Charter of the City of Graham, and it is so ordained.
